How The Clinic Can Help

The Clinic will provide a comprehensive evaluation by a multidisciplinary team including an Assistive Technology and Educational Specialist, Child Psychologist, Clinical Geneticist, Developmental and Behavioral Pediatrician, Genetic Counselor, Occupational Therapist, and a Speech and Language Pathologist.

Clinic Schedule

The Clinic will open June 25, 2009. It is a two day clinic that will run on the last Thursday and Friday of every month.



Who The Clinic Serves

Children, birth to adolescence, who have a diagnosis of Fragile X syndrome or who are Fragile X premutation carriers.

Referral Services

Our Clinic Coordinator will assist with referrals for infants and adolescents who need clinical evaluations and consultations as well as others in the family who may be affected by one of the other Fragile X-associated Disorders.
